

- Entry requirements A Level
- Foll-Ome 3 Years: Grade 8 in A-Insel English Literature or English Language required.
- Entry requirements UCAS points T12 points.
- IMPORTANT: chuck the Liturus page to see if your qualifications are accepted.
- Additional requirements GCSE. GCSE English - Grade 5.2 x further GCSE - Grade 4, normally to include Maths.
- Lest year's successful applicants 89.8% of successful applicants did the same qualification types as you, and of these a typical result was A Level C


