
A Level History

Unit 1: The Tudors, 1485-1603

Unit 2: USA, 1945-1980

Unit 3: NEA - an independent investigation of 4500 words. You can choose from Poverty or Public Health with a 100 year focus between 1750 and 1950. The NEA also allows you to incorporate local history research into your investigation.
