Art, craft and design GCSE.

Assessments Student must complete both components.

Component 1:

Portfolio + What's assessed

A portfolio that in total shows explicit coverage of the four assessment objectives. It must include a sustained project evidencing the journey from initial engagement to the realisation of intentions and a selection of further work undertaken during the student's course of study.

60% of GCSE Non-exam assessment (NEA) set and marked by the school/college and moderated by AQA during a visit. Moderation will normally take place in June.

Component 2:

Externally set assignment

What's assessed

Students respond to their chosen starting point from an externally set assignment paper relating to their subject title, evidencing coverage of all four assessment objectives.

Preparatory period followed by 10 hours of supervised time.

40% of GCSE Non-exam assessment (NEA) set by AQA; marked by the school/college and moderated by AQA during a visit. Moderation will normally take place in June.

The four assessment objectives:

- 1. Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources
- 2. Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes.
- 3. Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses.
- 4. Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language.
