

Before starting

- Get permission to do the mission and make sure the weather is not going to turn dangerous.
- Make sure you let someone know where you are going and what time you'll be back.
- Always pack some basic kit: a watch, a fully-charged phone or some change for a phone box and basic survival kit (including any medication you take, some plasters, a snack and drink). Pack a map and compass too for navigating and marking discoveries.
- Get into a team whenever doing the more challenging missions. Three is a magic number. If one of you gets hurt, one person can stay with them while the other goes for help. Agree a call (hoooo!) sign and a place where you can meet if you get split up.

- Hatch a plan in case it all goes wrong. Where could you go to get help? Who would you call?




Explore using one sense at a time.
