BTEC L3 EXTENDED CERTIFICATE IN BUSINESS

- Level 3 course same as A Level
- 4 units over 2 years
- 2 portfolios internally assessed by your teacher
- 1 CCA type external assessment
- 1 written exam

YEAR 1

- 2 units of work
- 1 Portfolio, 1 Controlled Assessment
- Gives you the opportunity to resit the external CCA unit if needed (you keep the best score)
- Unit 1 Exploring Business (25% of final marks)
- Unit 2 Developing a Marketing Campaign (25% of your final marks)

YEAR 2

- 1 portfolio marked by your teacher and moderated by Pearson
- Gives you the opportunity to resit the external exam unit if needed (you keep the best score)
- Unit 3 Personal and Business Finance exam (33% of your final marks)
- Unit 8 Recruitment and Selection Process (17% of final marks)

- Portfolio work can be assessed and feedback given back for a second (final) submission
- Not 100% exam based like many subjects!
- You can build your marks up gradually throughout the course and not just rely on your exam performance at the end of Year 2 like most other A Levels

- In order to give students a resit opportunity for both the CCA and the written examination, students will need to continue with this course for the full two years.
- Any student leaving after Year 1 will gain an AS level equivalent qualification if they have scored enough 'points'
