<u>NEA:</u> two 1200-1500 word essays responding to a different text and linking to a different aspect of the Critical Anthology

#### Paper 1A Aspects of Tragedy

In preparation for this exam you will study 3 texts:

- 1. Shakespeare text
- 2. Drama text
- 3. Further text

The drama or further text has to be pre-1900

#### Paper 2A Elements of Crime Writing

In preparation for this exam you will study 3 texts:

- 1. Post-2000 prose text
- 2. Pre-1900 poetry text
- 3. Further text
