## ▶ Entry requirements:

- ▶ GCSE Grade 7 or better in Maths
- ▶ Also studying A level Maths

## ▶ Examination (Edexcel):

- ▶ 4 equally weighted exams each of 1 hour 30 minutes. 2 exams are compulsory and are on core pure maths and 2 exams are option modules that can be chosen from Discrete and Decision, Further Statistics, Further Mechanics and Further Pure

## ▶ Post 18 opportunities:

- ▶ This is a highly regarded subject within the areas of Maths, Computing and Engineering and studying this at A level can result in favourable offers from universities.
