

# Core Maths

## ▶ Entry requirements:

- ▶ GCSE Grade 5 or better in Maths

## ▶ Examination (AQA):

- ▶ 2 equally weighted exams each of 1 hour 30 minutes. 1 exam is on the compulsory content and 1 on the optional content

## ▶ About the qualification:

- ▶ This is a one year course that is equivalent to an AS level qualification. As such this would be chosen in addition to 3 other A levels but cannot be chosen alongside A level Maths.

## ▶ Course overview:

- ▶ The compulsory content includes Maths for Personal Finance, Estimation and Analysis of Data, then there is an option module which is chosen from Statistical Techniques, Critical Paths and Risk Analysis and Graphical Techniques
